
JUNIPER AUTOTEST

Welcome to the 2020 Juniper Autotest and to the Motorsport UK British, BTRDA and Southern championship contenders. After another successful visit last year, we have moved dates yet again due to Easter, and are again at the Silverstone Circuit in Northamptonshire. We will have lots of space to lay out the three test areas on their nice smooth sealed surface area, and there will be tweaks to the design of the test areas. Also, as we will be running as part of the Vintage Sports-Car Club race weekend, you will also have access to the racing on the track on both days, which is for pre-1940 cars and pre-1961 racing cars.

Hopefully we will be able to speed through the day's proceedings to allow you to either get away early or spend some time looking around the racing car paddock. Your early entries would be appreciated and to help this, class starting order will be determined by the earlier you enter; the further to the back you run (or you can nominate to run earlier if preferred).

This will be a ticketed event to gain access into the circuit, with tickets being sent out during the week prior to the event, and each competitor will receive two tickets, with marshals getting one ticket each. If you need more, please let me know! Under 15s go free.

Hot & cold food and drink, plus toilets, will be available all day from the nearby onsite facilities.



SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

- 1. The Boundless by CSMA, North East London Group will organise a Clubmans permit Autotest on Sunday 19th April 2020 at the Silverstone Circuit, Towcester, Northamptonshire NN12 8TN.
- 2. The meeting will be held under the General Regulations of Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for this event.
- 3. Motorsport UK Permit ... 115412 ... has been issued.
- 4. The event is open to members of Boundless by CSMA, BTRDA, Bedford CC and up to 14 other clubs upon request, and to registered entrants in the following championships:
 Motorsport UK British Autotest, Demon Tweeks Direct BTRDA Autotest, BTRDA Allrounders and Southern Autotest.
- 5. The event is a qualifying round of the following championships:-
 - Motorsport UK British Autotest
 - Demon Tweeks Direct BTRDA Autotest
 - BTRDA Allrounders
 - Southern Autotest
- 6. All competitors must produce a valid Motorsport UK Competition Licence, Championship Registration card and/or Club Membership Card.
- 7. The programme of the meeting will be as follows:- Scrutineering starts at 08:30 and any competitor not signed on by 10:00 may be excluded. Drivers briefing will be at 10:15. The first car will start at 10:30.
- 8. The event will consist of 5 classes as follows:-

Class A - Saloon Cars under 11ft overall length

Class B - Saloon Cars over 11ft overall length

Class C - Sports Cars and Sports Kit Cars

Class D - Specials

Class E - Road Going Cars (Must be taxed and have a current MOT)

Class F - Road Going Kit Cars (Must be taxed and have a current MOT)

Cabriolet saloons with the hood down will run in the appropriate sports car class. All cars must comply with the Motorsport UK tyre and vehicle regulations. **Note: 1B or 1C tyres will not be allowed.** All cars MUST be silenced. Overall length will be determined by the Parkers Used Car Guide, or if not given, by the manufacturers catalogue.

9. Awards will be presented as follows:-

All awards are perpetual except named trophies (*) which are to be held for 11 months. No competitor may win more than one award. The entry list opens with the publication of these SR's and closes on Saturday 18th April 2020 (subject to minimum numbers being reached on Tuesday 14th April). The entry fee is £40 if received by Friday 10th April and £45 after this date and before the closing date.

Places can only be allocated to entries received by the Entries Secretary, on either the official entry form, or via completing the online entry form at http://boundlessevents.uk, and will only be accepted when full payment has been received.

Should any of the minimum figures not be reached the Organisers have the right to cancel the meeting or amalgamate classes as necessary. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt. Entry fees will be refunded at organiser's discretion.

- 14. Results will be on display during the day and provisional results announced as soon as possible following the last finisher. Protests must be made within 15 minutes of the results being announced as provisional, otherwise they will be declared final and the awards presented. Results will be posted to all competitors.
- 15. Any protest must be made in accordance with Section C5.
- 16. (a) Details of tests will be sent with the Final Instructions.
 - (b) Each driver will have all times to count.
 - (c) Timing will be by hand held digital watches to 0.1 sec.
 - (d) The starting signal will be "in your own time".
 - (e) Order of attempting the tests will be numerical/class order.
- 17. Practising will be allowed, but only in the designated area, which opens after 9:30am.
- 18. Competitors will be identified by organiser supplied numbers.
- 19. Marking and Penalties as printed in the appropriate section of the Motorsport UK General Regulations:-

M9.4 (c) incorrect test +20 seconds

(d) cones 5 seconds (e) lines 5 seconds

- 20. All other General Regulations of the Motorsport UK apply as written except for the following:-
 - H35.1.4 A Novice must not have won an award on an authorised autotest, other than a team award, since 18/04/15.
 - M5.1 In consequence of the whole event taking place on private property, vehicles need not be licensed. Classes A-D only.
